



DAY 16 - PRAYER TOPICS

As you spend time with Jesus today, here are some suggestions to bring to Him in prayer.

OUR MAIN FOCUS:

BREAKTHROUGH & BREAKOUT FOR EASTER! Isaiah 61:1-5, “The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is upon me, for the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to comfort the brokenhearted and to proclaim that captives will be released and prisoners will be freed. He has sent me to tell those who mourn that the time of the Lord’s favor has come, and with it, the day of God’s anger against their enemies. To all who mourn in Israel, he will give a crown of beauty for ashes, a joyous blessing instead of mourning, festive praise instead of despair. In their righteousness, they will be like great oaks that the Lord has planted for his own glory. They will rebuild the ancient ruins, repairing cities destroyed long ago. They will revive them, though they have been deserted for many generations.”

TODAY’S PRAYER TOPICS

1. THE CONFLICT IN UKRAINE – Humanitarian aid is coming in from around the world. (Thank you for giving!) Workers and goods must travel on dangerous roads from basecamps in neighboring countries to their destinations inside Ukraine. Please pray for safety and success for their journeys.

2. THE ALFC SANCTUARY TECH TEAM – The team in the booth supports everything that happens on the stage. They mix the sound in the room, the sound and video for our streamed services, and organize and present the images and slides on the screens. They also respond in real-time to comments that come in on Facebook and YouTube, supporting the ministry to those watching at home. Please pray for growth: in skills, in reach for our online services, in technical capability, and in the size of our team.

Pray that they will be technically excellent and that they will reach more viewers than ever before—specifically, viewers who don’t know Jesus and have been hesitant about coming to an in-person service or are homebound. Please pray that people will give their lives to Jesus and begin to participate in church because of our online services.
